- Strengthened partnerships between professionals, businesses, and advocates for social change.

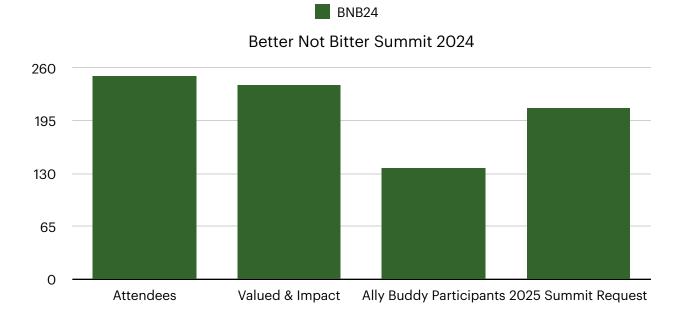
IMPACT METRICS
